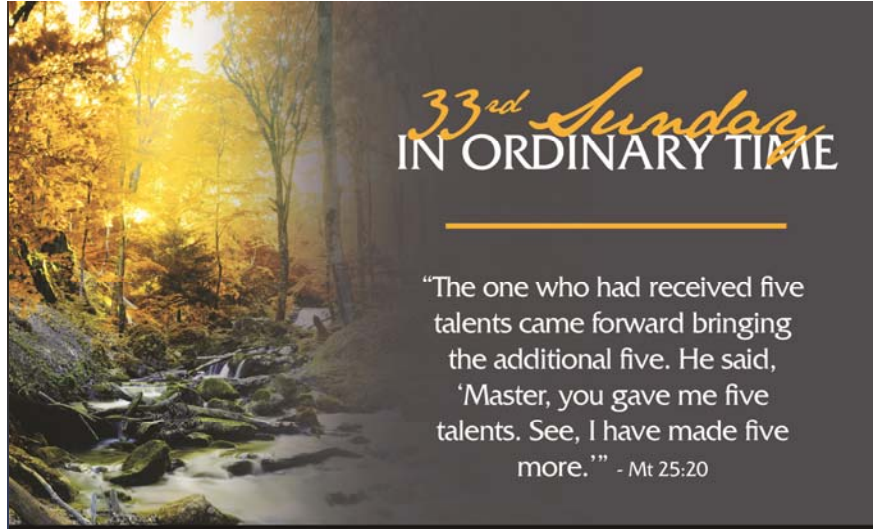

## Consideration of our Christian Commitment: Ordinary Time Saints

**It was good beginning this month gifted with the Feast of All Saints. As we continue through this month of Thanksgiving, today the Scriptures** remind us of the many gifts with which we have been blessed, gifts which we use to express our gratitude for the love God has shared with us, gifts we are called to use to bless our neighbor.

**On Saturday, November 4, Sr. Rani Maria was beatified by Pope Francis and became known as Blessed Rani Maria.** As a member of the Franciscan Clarist



Congregation, she worked among the poor and marginalized in Madhya Pradesh (Central India). Her work of educating the poor about their rights brought her into conflict with landlords and money-lenders. On February 25, 1995, Samundar Singh (a hitman) stabbed her 54 times while she travelled in a public bus. Most of the passengers ran away in fear; none came to her rescue. She died on the road.

Our story does not end here. The rest is really incredible and a real witness to the gift of God's love and forgiveness present in our lives. Samundar Singh was convicted of murder and sentenced to life imprisonment. Sr. Rani Maria's family members, however, visited him in prison. Her mother kissed his hands as a sign of forgiveness. Sr. Selmy (younger sister of Rani Maria and a member of the same congregation) tied a "rakhi," or sacred thread, on the hand of Samundar, signifying that he was her brother. Samundar repented and was released in 2006. On November 1, we celebrated the feast of all the holy women and men in heaven. Like this brave nun, there are many people from different times and places who have given witness by their faith, courage, love, forgiveness, humility, or commitment, among other virtues. Some of them have been canonized saints, others have joined the communion of saints by being who they were or by doing the best that they could — cooking in kitchens for their families, filing papers in crowded offices, teaching children in classrooms, or by tilling the fields under the hot sun. Some witnessed to their faith as did the family of Sister Rani Maria, by being forgiving and loving. They refused to conform to the values of the world, to live self-centered lives. Rather, they were sensitive to the needs of their neighbors. Like Sr. Rani Maria and her family we are invited to stand firm and live lives of faith that are just.

**It was a good feeling welcoming Chad Street to my office a couple of weeks ago as he brought me Eagle Scout**

**forms to sign.** For an Eagle Scout project, he has offered



to gather together a group who will refurbish the Prayer Garden. The Stations of the Cross (from the old church on Range Ave.) were recently repainted by Tina Guillory, so when Chad and his group are finished with the Prayer Garden, it will be an even better place to gather for prayer in the course of the day.

**This Sunday we celebrate the Rite of Acceptance for those Inquirers who have been seeking to learn more of the Catholic Christian way of life.** Most of them have been joining us on Thursday evenings since August 10<sup>th</sup> seeking to learn more about the Catholic way of worship and living. There have been talks like you might have in a classroom, but also witness talks, and always good fellowship before, during and after the presentations. They are a wonderful group of Inquirers and it will be a delight to celebrate the Rite of Acceptance into the Catechumenate with them.

**We received word that our gross income from the Fall Festival was \$136,000.** We have paid some bills, but still have more to pay. We will let you know what our real income (profit) will be when all bills are paid. We thank along with the Festival Chairpersons and workers **Michelle Holmes** who has done the bookwork and much paperwork work before during and continues to do after the Festival.

**This week we celebrate Thanksgiving and we will celebrate the Thanksgiving Eucharist** at 6:00 p.m. Thanksgiving Eve and Thanksgiving morning at 8:30. A tradition we have is the **Blessing of Food brought from home and Breads** at the end of the Eucharist for parishioners to take home, break and share when they pray Grace and dine around the Thanksgiving table. It is a nice way of linking together the "Parish Church" and "Domestic Church," the Table of the Lord with our tables at home, One Body in the Lord. Love,

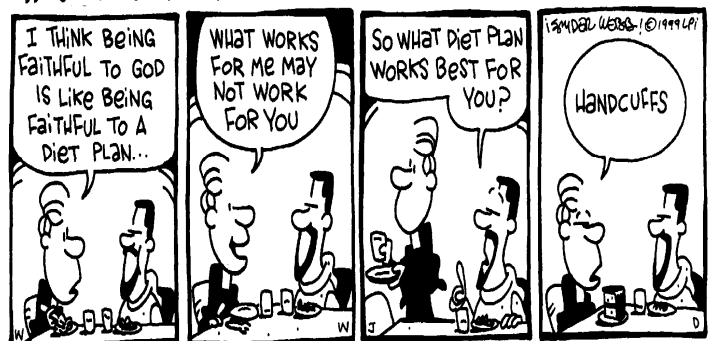
